ADDITIONAL OBSERVATIONS:

The process of eschatological history for the church moves through the book of Revelation from its inauguration (Rev 12:10) to its completion (Rev 11:15)

Three things that come together so that the Lord's eschatological pruposes for human history are accomplished: affliction/suffering, kingdom, and perseverance (Rev 1:9 & II Cor 11:22-33; 12:12)

John is <u>in</u> Patmos, <u>in</u> the Spirit, and <u>in</u> the Day of the Lord (Rev 1:9, 10)

In the Old Testament, Israel is represented by a single menorah in the Holy Place in the tabernacle of Moses (Ex. 25:31-40), but in the vision of Jesus unveiled in Revelation 1, He stands in the midst of seven lampstands that represent the church in multiplicity (see Ezek 11:14-21)
